Food & Beverage

Visiting teams for league play enjoy complimentary food and beverages provided by their respective SCC host teams. During SCC-sponsored events, only food and beverages provided by SCC are allowed. At other times, SCC members may bring their own food. Adults may bring and consume their own alcoholic beverages before 4:00pm only. Alcoholic beverages must be sourced from SCC after 4:00pm or whenever an SCC bartender is present.



While at the SCC Paddle Facility

Park only in marked spaces. Please do not park in the turn-around area in the south end of the parking lot or in designated fire lanes.

Warm up and play on the courts reserved for your group. Courts are numbered #1 through #6 from the south to the north. If you are a member of a visiting team for league play, a captain from one of the SCC teams can tell you which courts are assigned to your team.

Outside of league play, please be respectful of the start and stop times associated with your court reservation. When finished playing, please make sure all balls, cups, bottles and personal items are removed from the courts.

Private parties using several paddle courts and the paddle house may be scheduled on select Friday and Saturday evenings during the paddle season. If you are playing on a reserved court at the same time as a private party, you may use the paddle house beverage services and restrooms, but please use common courtesy and be respectful of the private party.

Children under 12 should be supervised by an adult at all times. SCC staff is not responsible for watching unattended children.

Health, Safety, Cell Phones

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and medical kit are located near the restrooms in the paddle house. No smoking is allowed in the paddle house or on the paddle courts. Wear relatively flat-soled (not deep-waffle-soled) tennis shoes. Stretching prior to playing paddle is strongly recommended. Cell phone use is allowed.
